Jamboree Rules/Notes

We shall follow high school football and league rules with the exceptions listed below:

- There will be 10 minutes allocated for warm up between matchups.
- Each matchup will consist of two 12-minute running clock periods with a 5 min "halftime". Clock will only stop for timeouts or injuries.
- Each team will get one timeout per game, 1 minute long.
- A coin-flip will determine who starts on offense.
- No kickoffs or punts will be used.
- Offense will start at the 40-yard line going in.
- The team with the ball continues until they lose it by way of either a turnover, fumble, interception, or a turnover on downs.
- When the opposing team receives the ball, it will be reset at the 40- yard line.
- If the defensive team recovers a fumble or intercepts the ball, they will not be allowed to run the ball back. They will receive the ball on the 40-yard line.
- If a team scores a touchdown, there will be no extra point attempt, and the opposing team shall receive the ball.
- The longest penalty allowed will be 10 yards. If there is not enough room for a penalty, then the penalty shall be half the remaining distance of the field and/ or loss of a down. This is up to the discretion of the referees.

OTHER:

- Coaches will be allowed on the field between plays to arrange players and call plays but must leave before the ball is snapped.
- Every player must play in at least 2 halves of football. We want as many players to play as possible.
- Coaches may freely substitute players throughout the game.
