Kimberly T-Ball Rules

- 1. No alcohol. No profanity. **NO EXCEPTIONS**.
- 2. There will be no umpires. Both coaches shall work together to make accurate calls.
- 3. Bases shall be 45 feet apart.
- 4. Pitcher will stand approximately 30 feet from home plate. Pitcher may not leave this spot until ball is hit (1 warning will be given).
- 5. Batters and base runners must wear regulation helmets.
- 6. When the ball is hit it must travel 15 feet into fair territory before the runner may advance.
- 7. A player throwing the bat shall be given one warning. The next time that player throws the bat they will be called out. Runners on base may not advance.
- 8. Pitchers must go through the pitching motion before the batter may hit the ball off the tee.
- 9. The coach must adjust the tee to the players liking.
- 10. The batting line-up shall include the complete team roster. No chile should sit on the sidelines for two innings in a row.
- 11. Players, when not on the field, must stay in their sideline area.
- 12. One base on an overthrow into foul territory that is made within the infield. Runners may advance one base at their own risk.
- 13. When the ball is thrown in from the outfield to the infield, runners must stop at the base they are advancing to once the ball comes into the infield area.
- 14. A ball that is missed and remains in the outfield area is a live ball and the runners may advance at their own risk until the ball crosses the infield line. Runners tagged off their base will be called OUT.
- 15. Coaches may not aid players in advancing bases by carrying or pushing.
- 16. A runner missing the base should be called by the coach. That runner will return to the base missed and all runs made ahead of the runner will count.
- 17. No appeal plays.
- 18. 10 players on the field. A team may play with less if they have players missing but must play with 10 if there are 10 or more players available. Coaches may agree to have an equal number of additional number of players if they each have excess.
- 19. Games shall be 5 innings or 1 hour, whichever comes first.
- 20. Infielders must remain in position until the ball is hit.
- 21. At bat players will not be called for striking out. The coach will assist in adjusting the tee and player until the player is able to hit the ball into play.
- 22. The inning will end after 3 OUTS or after one round through the entire batting order, whichever comes first.
- 23. Coaches shall be responsible to be sure all players play and have fun.
- 24. No official score shall be kept.
- 25. Any decision not covered by these rules will be made on the basis of the standard Little League Baseball Rule Book.
